The Jason Flatt Act of 2012, WV Senate Bill 221, provides for the routine education of all professional educators and service personnel having direct contact with students on warning signs and resources to assist in suicide prevention. The education may be accomplished through self-review of resources and/or materials provided by the Jason Foundation.
